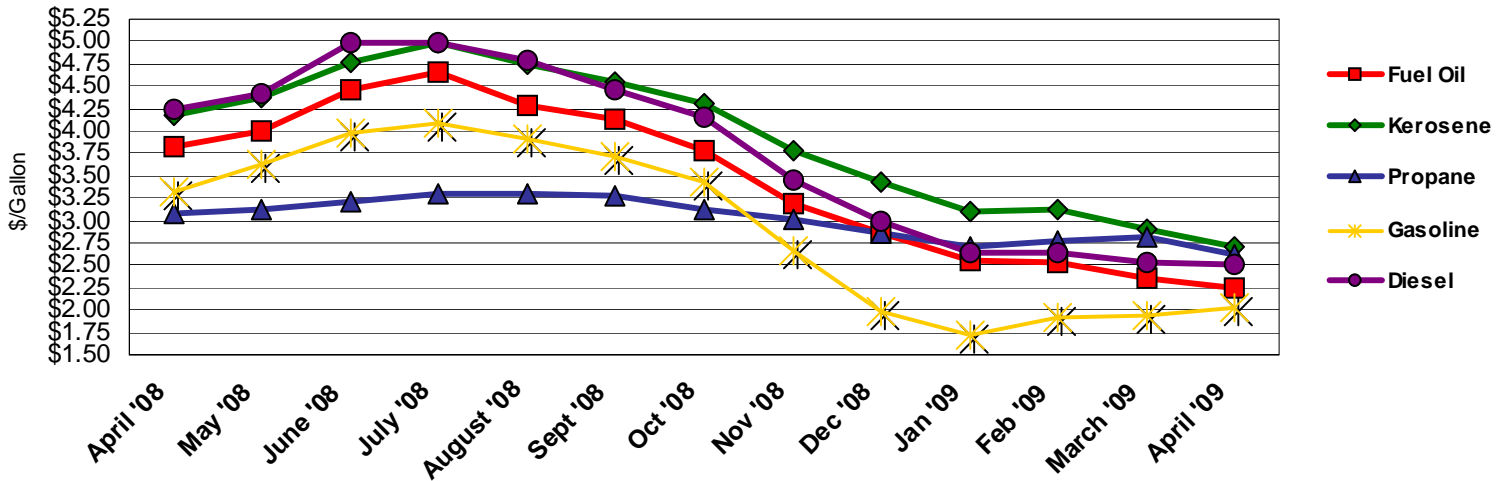

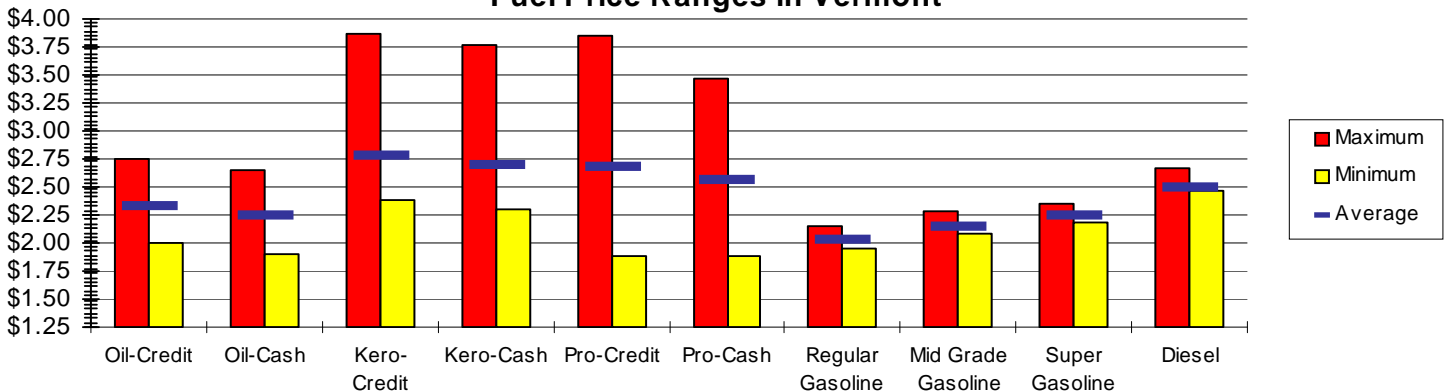

SUMMER FUELS OUTLOOK

The Energy Information Administration (EIA) is projecting that the national retail price of gasoline will average around \$2.23/gallon during the summer driving season (April-September) and diesel prices will average \$2.27/gallon. This is in stark contrast to prices last summer when gasoline averaged \$3.81/gallon and diesel averaged \$4.37/gallon.

NOTE: The Vermont Fuel Price Report is published monthly by the Vermont Department of Public Service. Prices are collected on or about the first Monday of each month and reflect dealer discounts for cash or self-service, except propane prices, which are an average of the credit and discount price.
