



PRICE PROTECTION PROGRAMS

The Department of Public Service will conduct its seasonal survey of fuel dealer price protection programs starting the first week of July. Additional information about price protection programs, including current average prices, will be included in the July Fuel Price Report.

GASOLINE AND DIESEL PRICES


The Energy Information Administration (EIA) has reported that the national average price for regular gasoline has continued to increase throughout the month of June, with a 17-cent increase from the first week of the month to last week of the month. Gasoline prices are expected to reach their summer seasonal peak in July with a monthly average around \$2.70 per gallon.

The New England average retail price of regular gasoline was \$2.50 per gallon the first week of June and \$2.69 per gallon as of June 22.

Diesel prices also rose throughout the months of May and June, with the national average price reaching \$2.62 on June 22. The New England average retail price of diesel was \$2.44 per gallon the first week of June and \$2.67 per gallon as of June 22.
