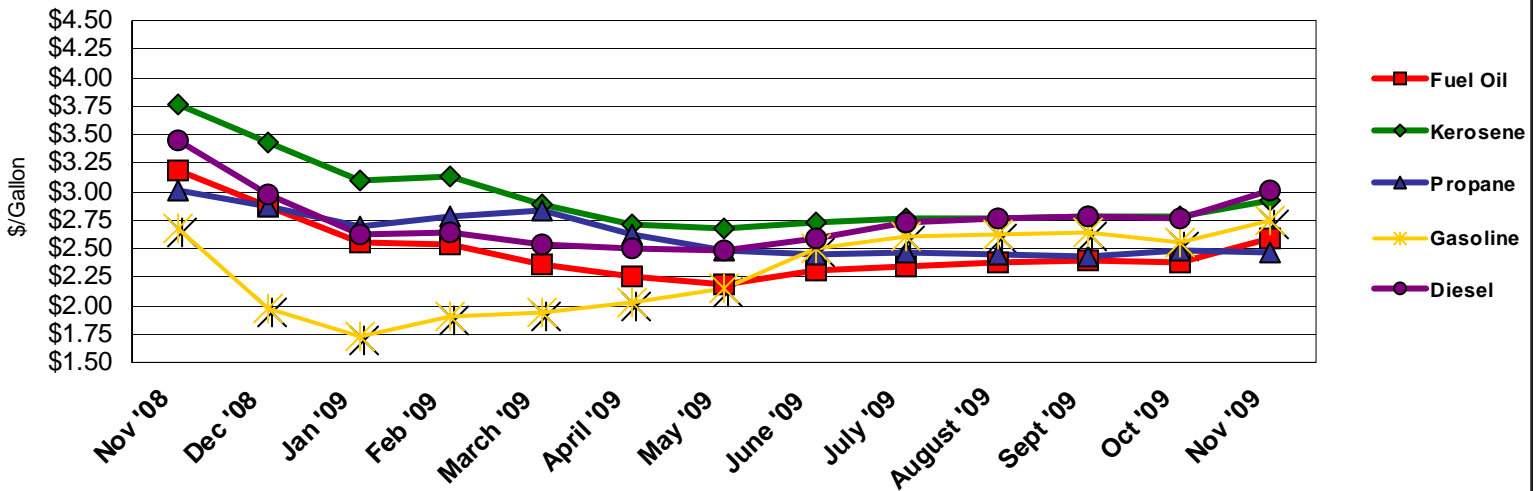

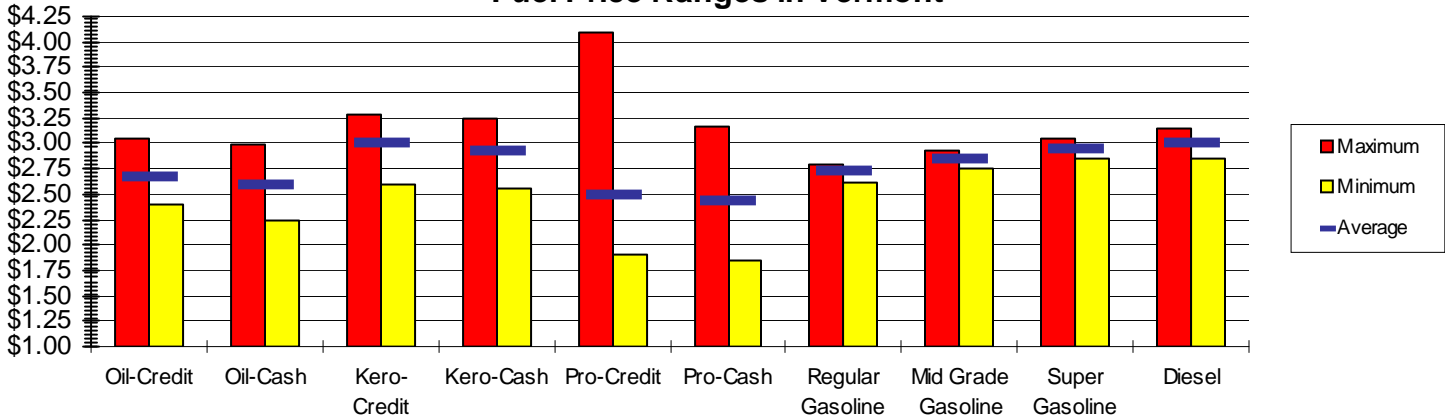

GASOLINE AND DIESEL PRICES

The Energy Information Administration (EIA) has reported that the national average retail price for regular gasoline has declined 5 cents from the first week of November to \$2.64 per gallon as of November 23rd. The New England average price is \$2.67 as of November 23rd. The EIA projects gasoline prices to average \$2.66 per gallon for October-December.

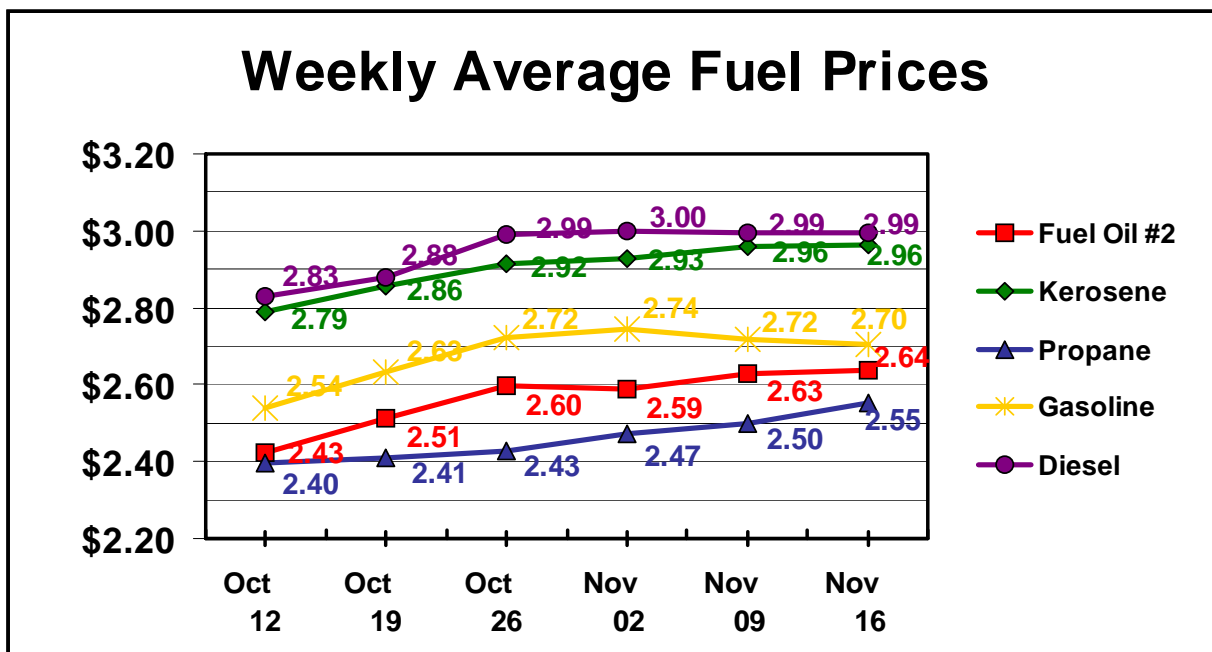
The national average retail price of diesel was \$2.79 per gallon as of November 23rd. The New England average price was \$2.87. The EIA projects diesel prices to average \$2.79 per gallon for October-December.

HEATING FUEL PRICES

The national average residential heating oil price was \$2.73 per gallon the first week of November and had only increased one cent by the week of November 16th. The EIA projects that heating oil prices will average \$2.80 per gallon this winter heating season (October - March).

The national average propane price was \$2.63 per gallon the first week of November and had increased to \$2.24 by the week of November 16th.
