On-Going Public Service Department Filings

- Appeal discontinuation Emergency Response Data System (ERDS) feed for the State Radiological Emergency Response Plan – *awaiting NRC action*
- Oppose reduction of the Emergency Planning Zone (EPZ) to the VY Site fence line – *awaiting NRC action*
- Continuing dialogue with NRC regarding valid uses of the VY Decommissioning Trust Fund (DTF)



Related to PSD Filings

- Actions on VT Petition to Intervene Actions on Waiver of 30-Day Notification for DTF Withdrawals LAR:
 - Oral Arguments before Atomic Safety Licensing Board (ASLB) conducted July 7
 - ASLB Ruled August 31 to grant Hearing on 2 of State's contentions
 - On September 22, VY requested to withdraw the LAR
 - Awaiting ASLB ruling on motion to withdraw LAR



Construction of Second Spent Fuel Dry Cask Storage Pad at VY Site

Certificate of Public Good Proceedings continue:

- Second Round Discovery on VY testimony completed July 6; VY Responses received July 20
- PSD & ANR Pre-Filed testimony completed August 19
- VY Discovery on Pre-Filed testimony received September 2; Responses due September 30
- VY Pre-File Rebuttal due October 21
- Discovery on VY Pre-File Rebuttal due November 4
