***Vermont Department of Public Service Announces January 10, 2022 Special Meeting of the Vermont Nuclear Decommissioning Citizens Advisory Panel for 2021 Annual Report Approval.***

Montpelier, VT – The Vermont Nuclear Decommissioning Citizens Advisory Panel (VT NDCAP) will hold a Special Meeting on Monday evening, January 10, 2022 from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM to review and potentially approve its 2021 Annual Report to the Vermont Legislature. While this meeting will be conducted primarily as a webcast and teleconference, in accordance with Vermont Open Meeting Law, the following physical location will be available for those wishing to attend and participate in person:
