Vermont Public Service Department Announces December 6, 2018 Meeting of the Nuclear Decommissioning Citizens Advisory Panel.

Montpelier, VT – The Public Service Department today announced that the next meeting of the Vermont Nuclear Decommissioning Citizens Advisory Panel (VT NDCAP) will be held on Thursday, December 6, 2018, from 6:00 PM to 7:45 PM in the Maria Lawrence Room at the [Vermont Agricultural Business Education Center \(VABEC\), 11 University Way, Brattleboro, VT](#). [University Way is accessible from Old Guilford Road in the south end of Brattleboro.]

Representatives from Entergy and the State of Vermont will provide updates on decommissioning activities at Vermont Yankee (VY). Additionally, the Panel will discuss the first draft of its 2018 Annual Report to the Vermont Legislature.
