Vermont Department of Public Service Announces Rescheduled Meeting of the Nuclear Decommissioning Citizens Advisory Panel.

Montpelier, VT – The Vermont Nuclear Decommissioning Citizens Advisory Panel (VT NDCAP) will hold its first meeting of 2021 on Monday evening, April 12, 2021 from 6:00 PM to 8:45 PM. This meeting was to have been held on March 15, but was rescheduled due to webcast platform issues outside of the State of Vermont’s control. In accordance with changes to Vermont Open Meeting Law in response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, this meeting will be conducted as a Microsoft Teams webcast and teleconference.
