

Clean Heat Standard

The Vermont Clean Heat Standard is a policy initiative aimed at reducing greenhouse gas emissions from heating fuels used in the state.

In 2023, the Vermont Legislature enacted [S.5](#), the “Affordable Heat Act.” By 2025, the Vermont Public Utility Commission must produce a report estimating the economic impact of the program on customers. At that time, the legislature must pass a second law to enact the full Clean Heat Standard.
