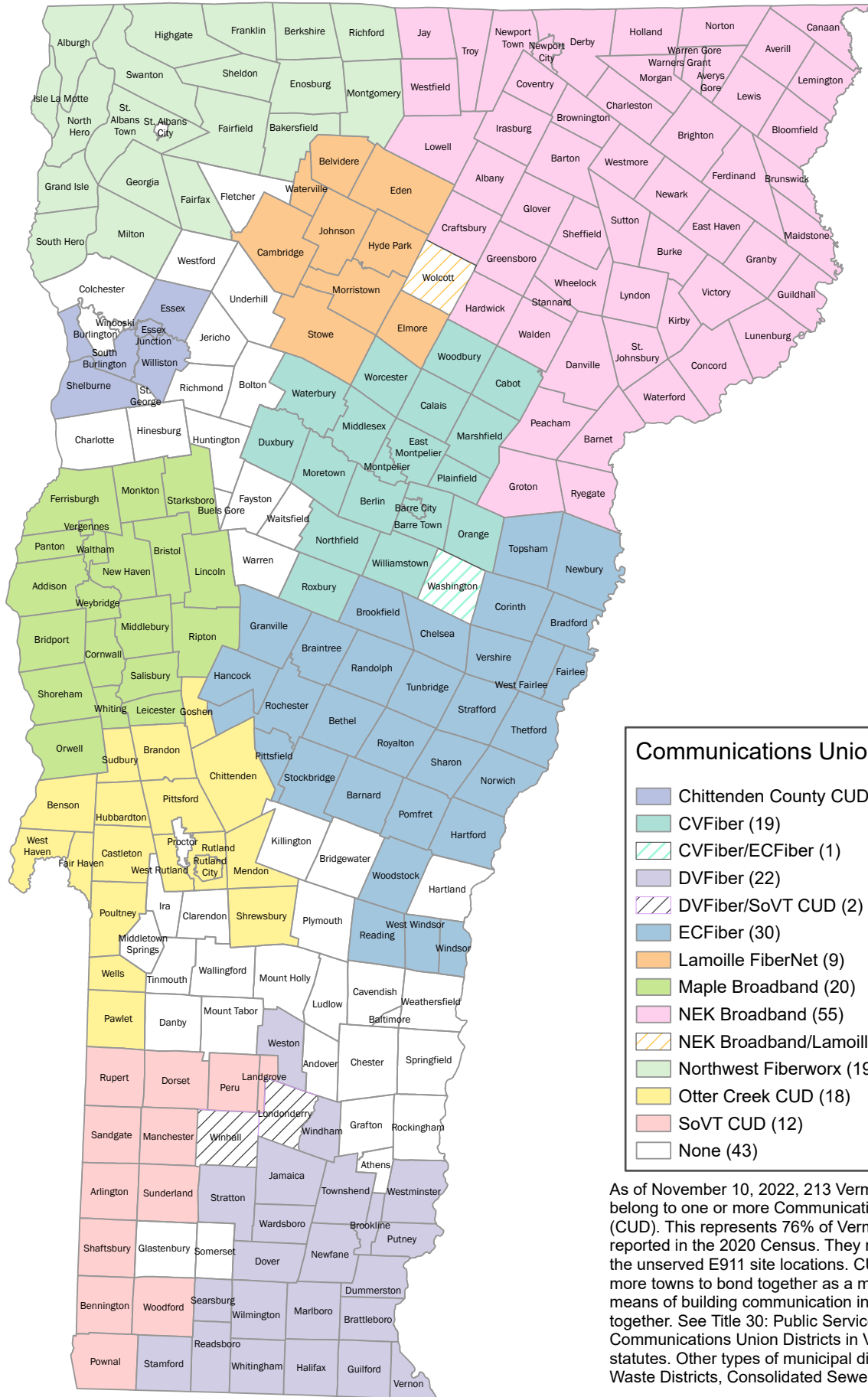


# Communications Union Districts



As of November 10, 2022, 213 Vermont municipalities belong to one or more Communications Union Districts (CUD). This represents 76% of Vermont's population reported in the 2020 Census. They represent 93% of the unserved E911 site locations. CUDs allow two or more towns to bond together as a municipal entity for a means of building communication infrastructure together. See Title 30: Public Service, Chapter 82: Communications Union Districts in Vermont state statutes. Other types of municipal districts include Solid Waste Districts, Consolidated Sewer Districts, etc.
