#### In the Works:

 Public Comment Period & Workshop Coming In November: As we wrap up the public engagement and technical analyses for this effort, we're beginning to review what we've heard and develop key takeaways. Looking forward, we plan to release a draft summary of our lessons learned for public review in mid-November. The public comment period will help us refine core takeaways that will inform recommendations to the legislature. We expect there to be multiple ways to weigh in during this period, including written comments and an interactive workshop in late November or early December. Stay tuned for more information!

# **Ongoing Efforts:**

- Technical Analysis Final Results Coming Early November: We are busy refining the draft results of the technical analysis in partnership with our consultant, Sustainable Energy Advantage, and the Stakeholder Advisory Group.
  - On October 10<sup>th</sup>, we hosted a workshop to review draft results and answer questions. A recording of the event and the related slides are now available online (view the recording, review <u>draft results slides from SEA</u> and <u>introductory</u> <u>slides from the Department</u>).
  - On October 17<sup>th</sup>, we met with the Stakeholder Advisory Group to dive deeper into the draft results. Slides from that meeting are <u>available for review here</u>.
  - Comments on the draft results due October 25<sup>th</sup>! In addition to feedback heard through these two meetings, we're accepting comments on the draft results until October 25<sup>th</sup>. Comments can be submitted via email to PSD.REPrograms@vermont.gov or via this webform.

# Wrapping Up

• Regional Engagement Opportunities: Say Watt?! Through September and October we partnered with <u>Vermont's Regional Planning Commissions (RPC)</u> to hold over 20 opportunities to hear from Vermonter's on what they think is most important to prioritize when thinking about where our electricity comes from.
