



GASOLINE AND DIESEL PRICES

The Energy Information Administration (EIA) has reported that on 1/7 (which is when the VT prices above were collected) the national average retail price of regular gasoline was \$3.11 per gallon and on 1/21 the average price had decreased to \$3.02. The New England average price was \$3.13 per gallon on 1/7 and \$3.09 on 1/21.

The national average retail price of diesel was \$3.38 per gallon on 1/7 and decreased to \$3.27 on 1/21. The New England average diesel price was \$3.64 per gallon on 1/7 and decreased to \$3.59 on 1/21. Additional information is available at: www.eia.doe.gov


Fuel Price Ranges in Vermont



HEATING OIL AND PROPANE PRICES


The national average residential heating oil price was \$3.37 per gallon on January 7th, which is an increase of over 97 cents from the same time last year. The EIA projects that heating oil prices will average \$3.14 per gallon in 2008.

Average residential propane prices increased for the fourteenth week in a row to \$2.56 per gallon as of January 7th, which is an increase of 57 cents compared to the same time last year.

NOTE: The Vermont Fuel Price Report is published monthly by the Vermont Department of Public Service. Prices are collected on or about the first Monday of each month and reflect dealer discounts for cash or self-service, except propane prices, which are an average of the credit and discount price.
