

GASOLINE AND DIESEL PRICES

The Energy Information Administration (EIA) has reported that regular gasoline prices have continued to fall for the last six weeks due to a sharp decline in crude oil prices. The national average retail price of regular gasoline was \$3.48 per gallon the first week of October and \$2.66 per gallon as of October 27th. The New England average price was \$3.34 per gallon the first week of October and \$2.64 per gallon as of October 27th.

The national average retail price of diesel was \$3.88 per gallon the first week of October and \$3.29 per gallon as of October 27th. The New England average price of diesel was \$4.04 per gallon the first week of October and decreased to \$3.57 as of October 27th.





WINTER FUELS OUTLOOK

The National (NOAA) is predicting this winter to be warmer than average in most of the country except for coastal CA and the Northeast, which is expected to be slightly colder than last winter. Based on that weather forecast the EIA is projecting retail heating oil prices to average \$3.90/gallon during the heating season (October-March) and propane prices are expected to average \$2.68/gallon. Heating oil and propane inventories are lower than last year and expected to remain relatively tight throughout the winter.
