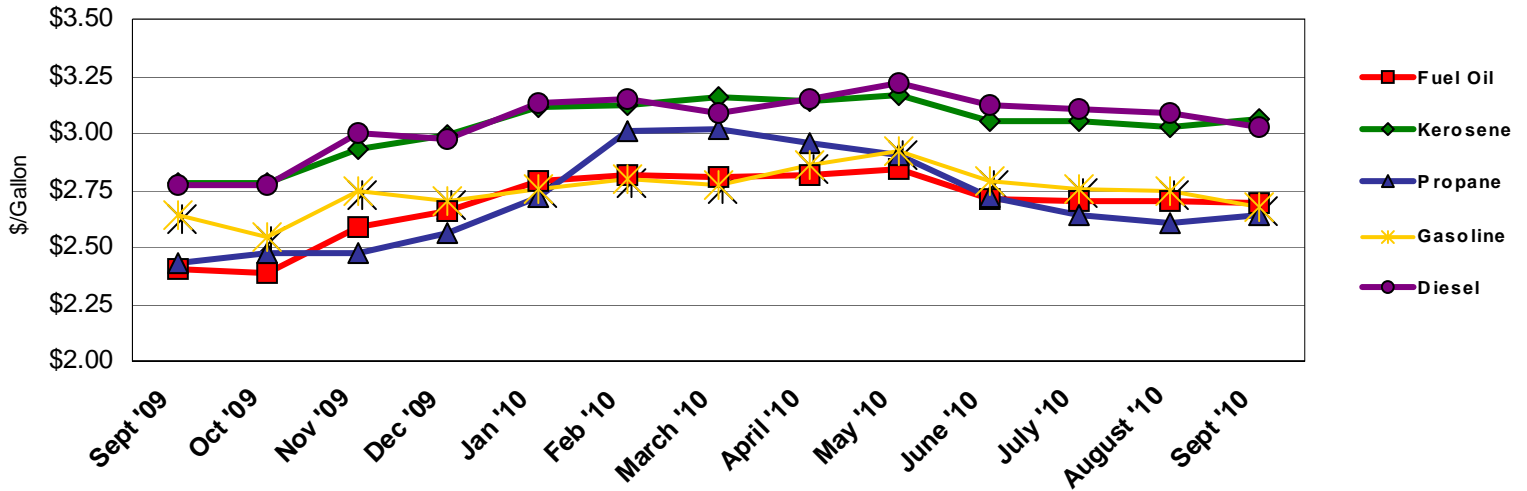

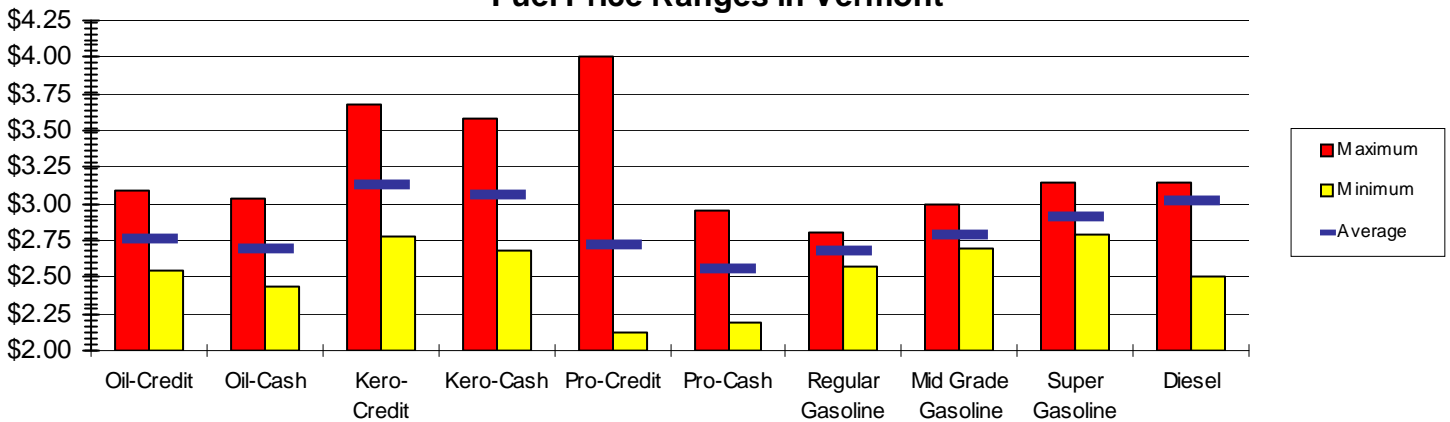

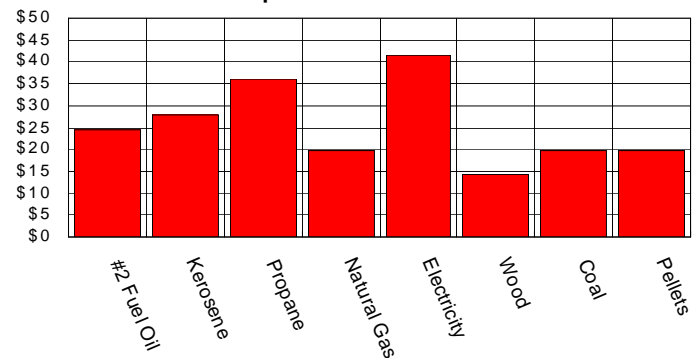
Fuel Price Ranges in Vermont

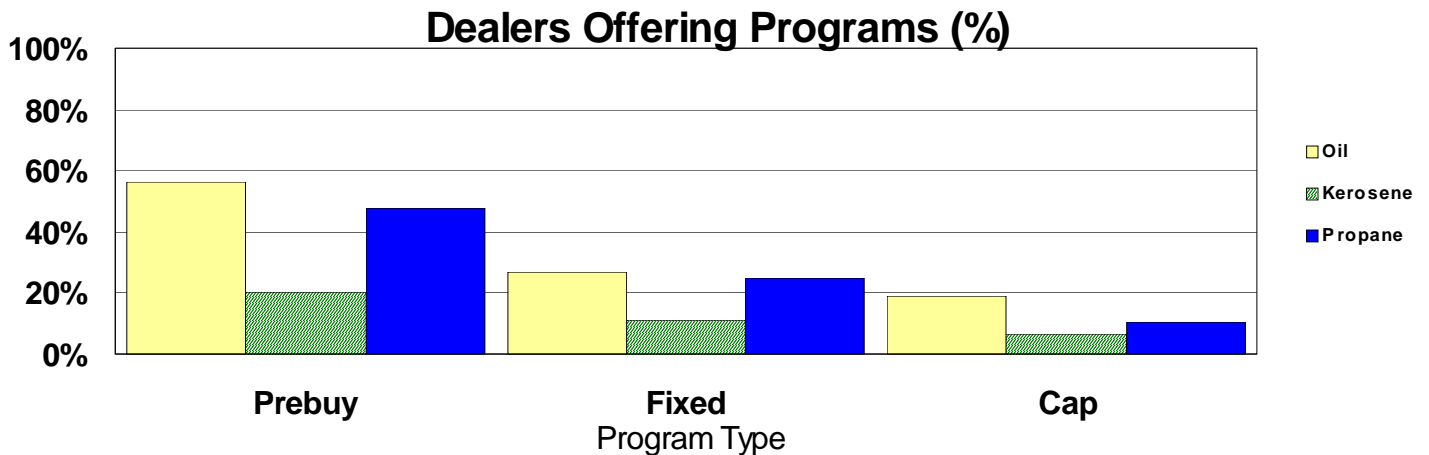
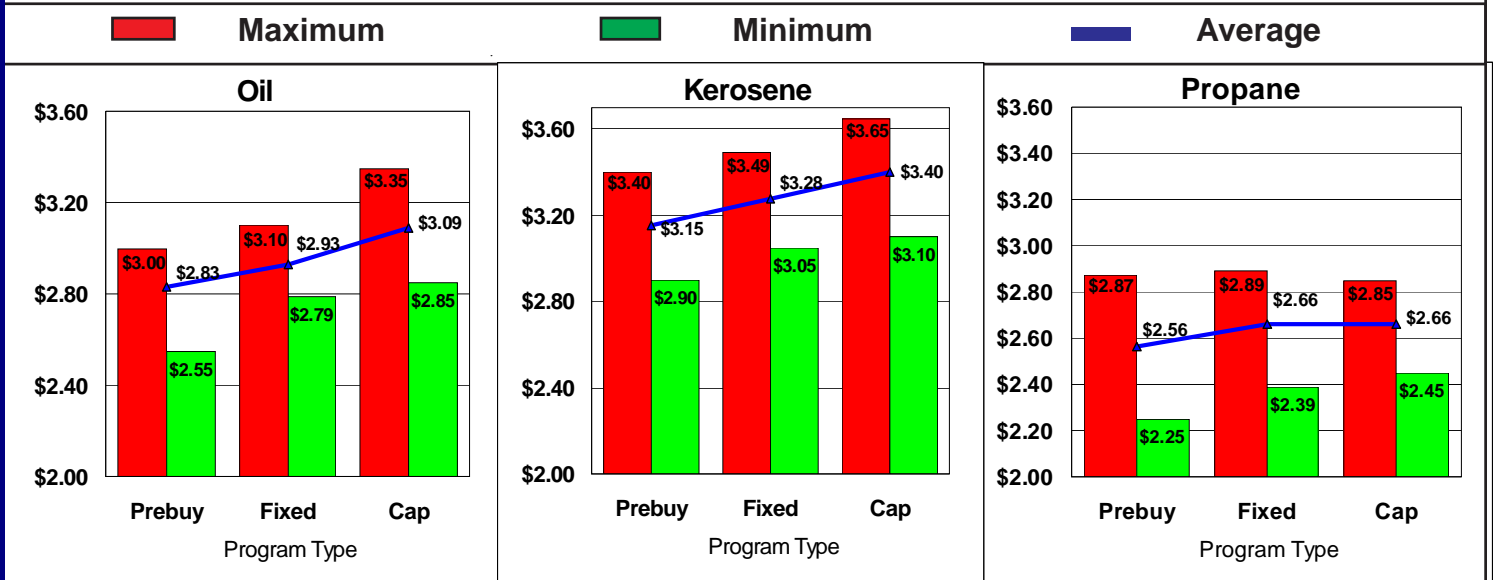

PRICE PROTECTION PROGRAMS

The charts below show the availability and average price per gallon for price protection programs as of **September 7th**, from a representative sample (approximately 80) Vermont fuel dealers.



NOTE: The Vermont Fuel Price Report is published monthly by the Vermont Department of Public Service. Prices are collected on or about the first Monday of each month and reflect dealer discounts for cash or self-service, except propane prices, which are an average of the credit and discount prices.
