

## WHO WE ARE

The Vermont Small Scale Renewable Energy Incentive Program is designed to provide funds to incentivize the installation of new renewable energy systems on the homes, businesses, institutions, and non-profit facilities of Vermont.

Funding is provided through the Vermont Clean Energy Development Fund, located in the Vermont Public Service Department. The Program is administered by the Renewable Energy Resource Center.

The Clean Energy Development Fund (CEDF) serves the citizens of Vermont by increasing local small-scale renewable energy generation while maximizing associated economic development. The CEDF has provided incentives to Vermont home- and business-owners for installing advanced wood heating, solar electric, solar water heating, wind, and micro-hydro systems.

## WOOD STOVE CHANGE-OUT INCENTIVE

The Vermont incentive for replacing old wood stoves with EPA certified wood and pellet stoves.

Beginning November 1, 2018



## DO YOU HAVE AN OLD STOVE?

If your old wood stove is not EPA certified, you may be eligible to receive an incentive to replace it with a cleaner, EPA 2020 certified wood or pellet stove!

## IS COST AN ISSUE? WE CAN HELP!

Our RERC program offers a:

- \$800 incentive for eligible cord wood stoves
- \$1000 incentive for eligible pellet stoves
- \$100 incentive to replace the catalyst in an existing EPA-certified wood stove

## HOW TO GET THE INCENTIVE:

1. Verify that your old stove is not EPA-certified (any stove prior to 1988 is not certified). For 1988 and newer stoves, check the EPA's historical certification (available at [www.rerc-vt.org](http://www.rerc-vt.org)) to ensure that your old stove is not on the list.
2. Find a Participating Retailer and select a qualifying EPA-certified replacement stove (list of qualifying models is available at [www.rerc-vt.org](http://www.rerc-vt.org)).
3. Purchase the new stove and receive your incentive discount from the retailer.
4. Your retailer will install the new stove, and recycle your old stove.
5. Your retailer will submit the incentive request and get reimbursed by the CEDF.



## OTHER STOVE PROGRAMS

### Windham County:

- \$650 rebate for wood/pellet stove purchase

### Vermont Electric Co-op

- \$150 bill credit for pellet stove purchase that replaced fossil fuel system

- Can be combined with other offers
