SEPTEMBER UPDATE - RENEWABLE ELECTRICITY POLICY & PROGRAMS REVIEW

The Clean and Renewable Electricity Team of the Vermont Public Service Department welcomes you to our September newsletter!

This newsletter is a monthly update to share what we're working on and how you can be involved in our ongoing review of Vermont's clean and renewable electricity programs and policies. Ongoing Efforts:

- Regional Engagement Opportunities: Say Watt?! Interested in participating in discussions about the future of electricity in Vermont? We've been partnering with <u>Vermont's Regional Planning Commissions</u> to hold a series of events through September and early October to engage with Vermonter's on what they think is most important to prioritize when thinking about where our electricity comes from. Over the next two weeks there are engagement opportunities in *Bethel (9/26), Middlebury (9/26), Rockingham (9/26), Wilmington (9/27), Windsor (9/28), Stowe (9/28), Rutland City (9/30), Central Vermont (10/4-10/6) and Virtually (10/4 & 10/11)!* Learn more and register (where requested) at https://publicservice.vermont.gov/regional-events. We hope you'll join us!
- **Technical Analysis October 10**th **Workshop:** We continue to work in partnership with our consultant, Sustainable Energy Advantage, and the <u>Stakeholder Advisory Group</u> to explore impacts of possible modifications to the Renewable Energy Standard. If you are

- interested in engaging in this work, we're holding a technical workshop on **Tuesday October 10th, from 12pm-3pm** to discuss draft results from the modeling. This workshop will be held virtually, meeting details and an agenda will be available on our website.
- Who should attend? The October 10th workshop is geared towards technical stakeholders who are interested in getting deep into the weeds on modeling outputs, data sets, and scenarios related to the draft results. We expect to hold another workshop in mid-November for a more general audience to discuss the final modeling results alongside other aspects of this public engagement effort. The November workshop will also offer an opportunity to begin considering possible recommendations for future policies and programs. More details to come!
