


- Competency-based apprenticeships focus is on learned skills, rather than a set time or duration of the apprenticeship.
- Abilities are emphasized over memorized knowledge.
- Skills are more important than the number of hours spent working on tasks.



# **Growing Your Workforce with Registered Apprenticeship**

- Each apprenticeship occupation has an occupation playbook (Appendix A) which was developed by industry experts
- The playbook has lists for the developmental skill building as well as the supplemental related instruction
- Additional occupations are under consideration




# **Grow Your Workforce from Within with TIRAP**

- Start with existing workers as apprentices in the first round to help iron out your processes.
- Cost-free participation, no membership required for TIRAP. No WIA membership needed.
