

Department Seeks Public Comments Regarding Potential Rate Increase

Vermont Water Utilities, Inc. (VWU) has advised the Department of its intention to file a revised tariff for its Georgia Station water system customers with the Public Utility Commission.

The Department of Public Service will be a party to the proceeding and will review the utility's records and forecasts to determine whether the utility's proposed rate increase is appropriate based on the costs associated with operating the system.

The Department of Public Service encourages ratepayers to follow the proceeding on the PUC website.

The Commission will assign a case number to VWU's filing. Once the case number has been assigned, the public will be able to read more about the rate case, by using the PUC's website at: <http://puc.vermont.gov/epuc-information/case-and-document-search>.
